Farm with melon cultivation for export to the USA, it has a productive area of approximately 104.8 ha, production is maintained seasonally between the months of November to May, there are about 120 employees to carry out the different cultivation tasks. At the time of the inspection, a tour of the cultivation areas is carried out, irrigation system installations, dining area, toilets and chemical warehouse are verified. On the farm, water from wells is used and stored in a reservoir, it is used to supply the water needs of the crop through the drip irrigation method. Fertilizer and pesticide applications are made by spray equipment. There is a chlorinator installed in the water line to maintain potability of irrigation water. At the time of the inspection, drip irrigation and manual control of weeds were observed, interviews were carried out with the available personnel.
